They always need some chutney or sambar to make an interesting combo. Finally, the mirchi bajjis - they make students cry

and sweat, but students remember them forever. So, a happy extended teachers's day to all the pizzas, idlis, sprouts, rasagullas and mirchi bajjis of Surana Educational Institutions.

Recently, during the alumni meet at Sophia's school, a very senior student who brought his child to the event approached me during dinner and said, "I don't see any of the faculty members who taught me, yet I am so happy to see how much the Institution has grown and evolved." Think of Viswanathan Anand, India's first Chess grand master- much about him, as today's conversations revolve around young sensations like Praggnanandhaa and Gukesh. However, that doesn't diminish or lower Anand's glory as India's first grandmaster.



Similarly, many young members of SEI may not know the people who laid the foundation of this institute, they may not know those people who have stood with me during difficult times and challenges, you may not know those people who have put life into this institution, but that doesn't mean their contributions are forgotten. They are, and always will be, the grandmasters of Surana. Yet, as time moves on, we must embrace change and look toward the future.

Friends, once a wife asked her husband, "Dear, when I die, where will I go?" the husband replied, "You'll go to hell." The wife then asked, "What will I get in hell?" the husband said, "You'll live with monkeys." She then asked, "Where will you go after you die?" The husband said, "I'll go to heaven." The wife asked, "What will you get in heaven?" the husband said, "beautiful angels." The wife smiled and said, "That's not fair! You get an angel to live with at home and angels in heaven, and I get a monkey to live with at home and monkeys in hell!"

Heaven and hell are our imagination and our own making. With the right mind set I am sure we can make every day in office a heaven. I always get energy and happiness seeing you all. There may have been times when I made decisions you did not like, just as there have been moments when I may not have agreed with your responses to certain situations. We're talking about an institution that is over 30 years old, and decisions made at one point in time cannot serve as permanent benchmarks. We're all human. I can make mistakes just as you do. But the real question is: are we collectively moving forward?

When I go to Vidyalaya, right from the primary kids to the ammas to the office staff, I get energy. Sandeep Pai's wit, Prakash's energy, at Peenya- Ramya's ability to balance work and family- how many of you know that she manages a farm? Do you think I can stay away from you all? I was kidding. I am going to continue asking for ranks, I am going to continue asking for admissions, I am going to continue asking questions, meeting you at Teacher's Day like this for the next 15 years.

I cannot stay away from you all.
